Directions: Cut out the letters at the bottom of the page and paste them next to the picture with the matching beginning sound.



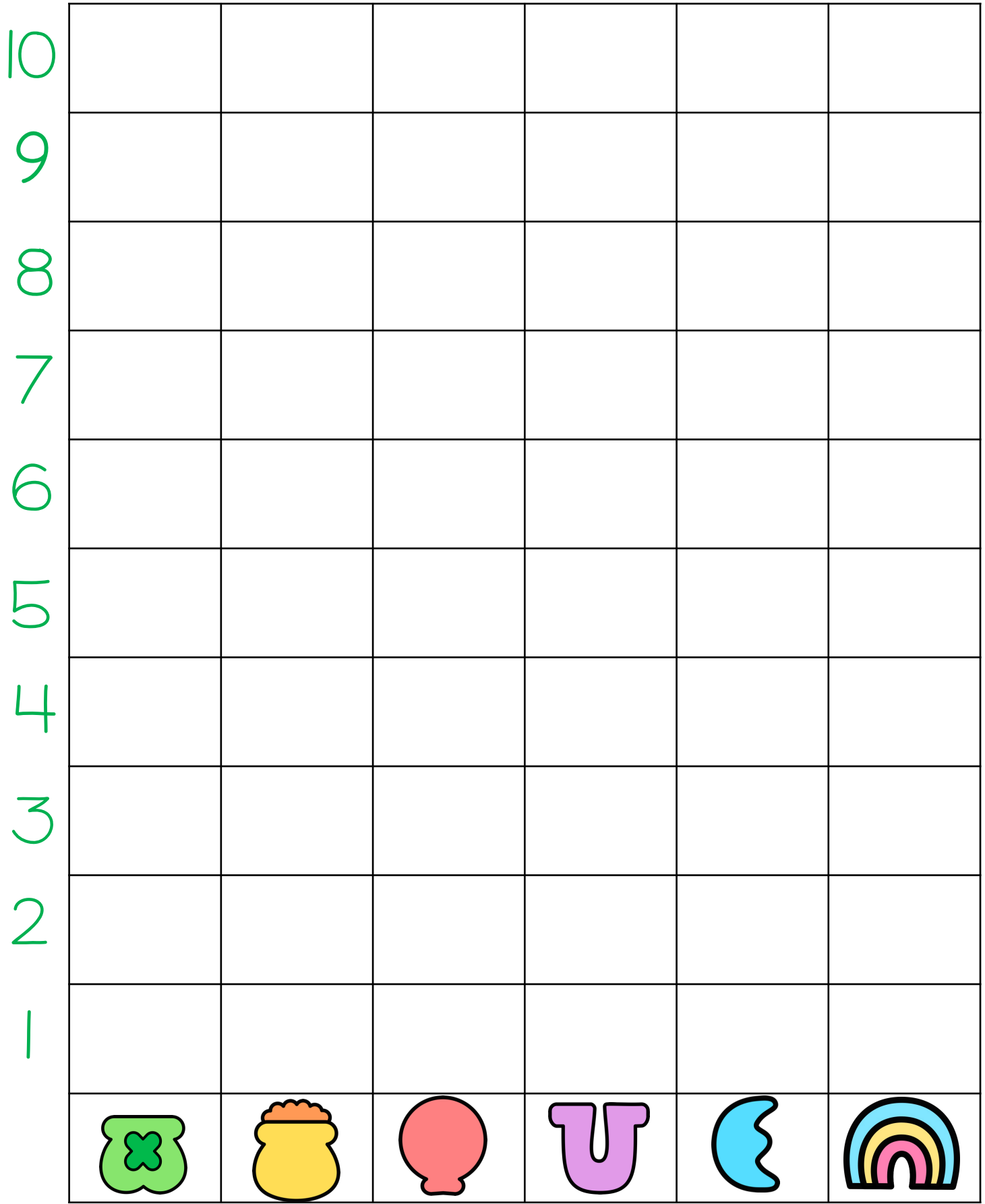
Lucky Charm Colors

Directions: Read the color word inside each of the Lucky Charm marshmallows and color them that color!



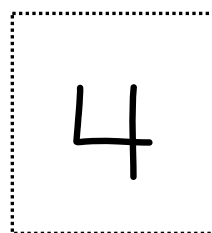
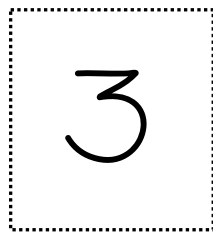
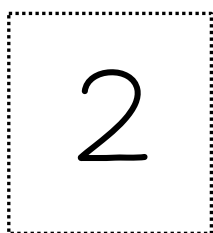
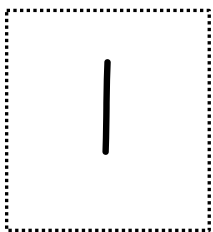
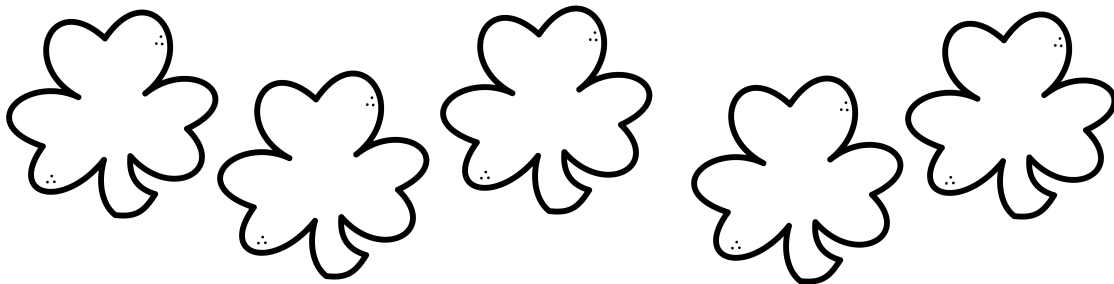
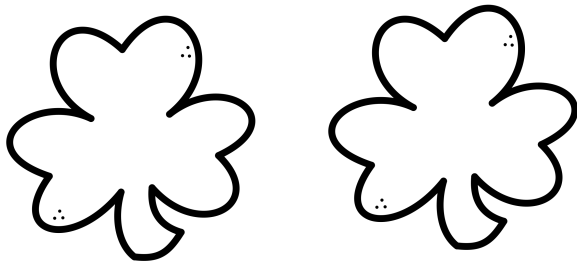
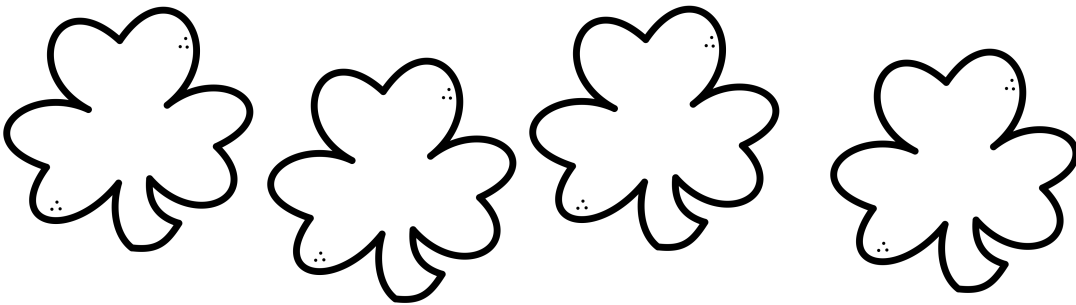
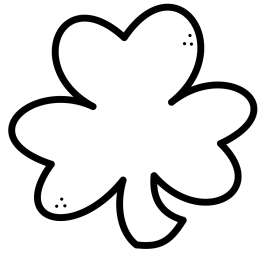
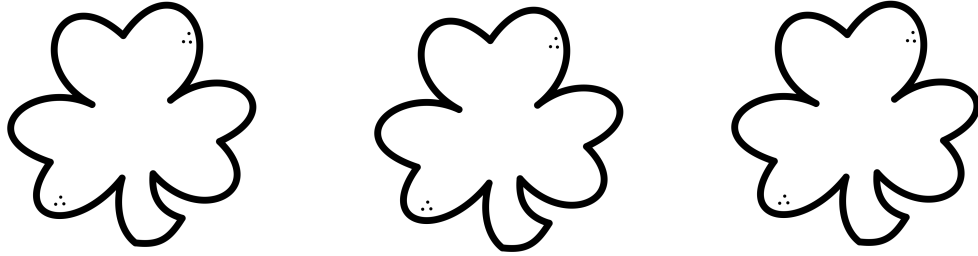
Lucky Charm Graphing

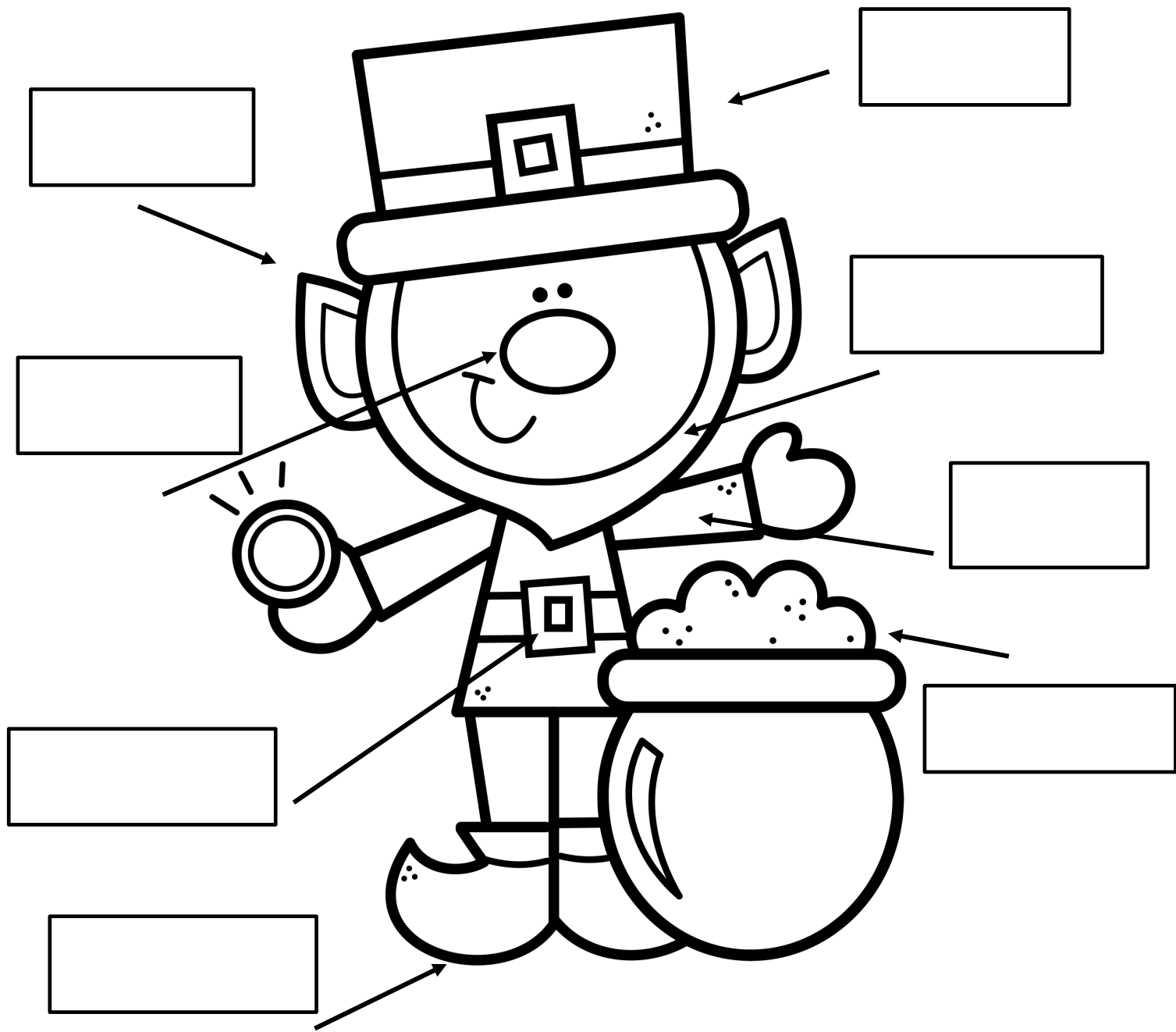

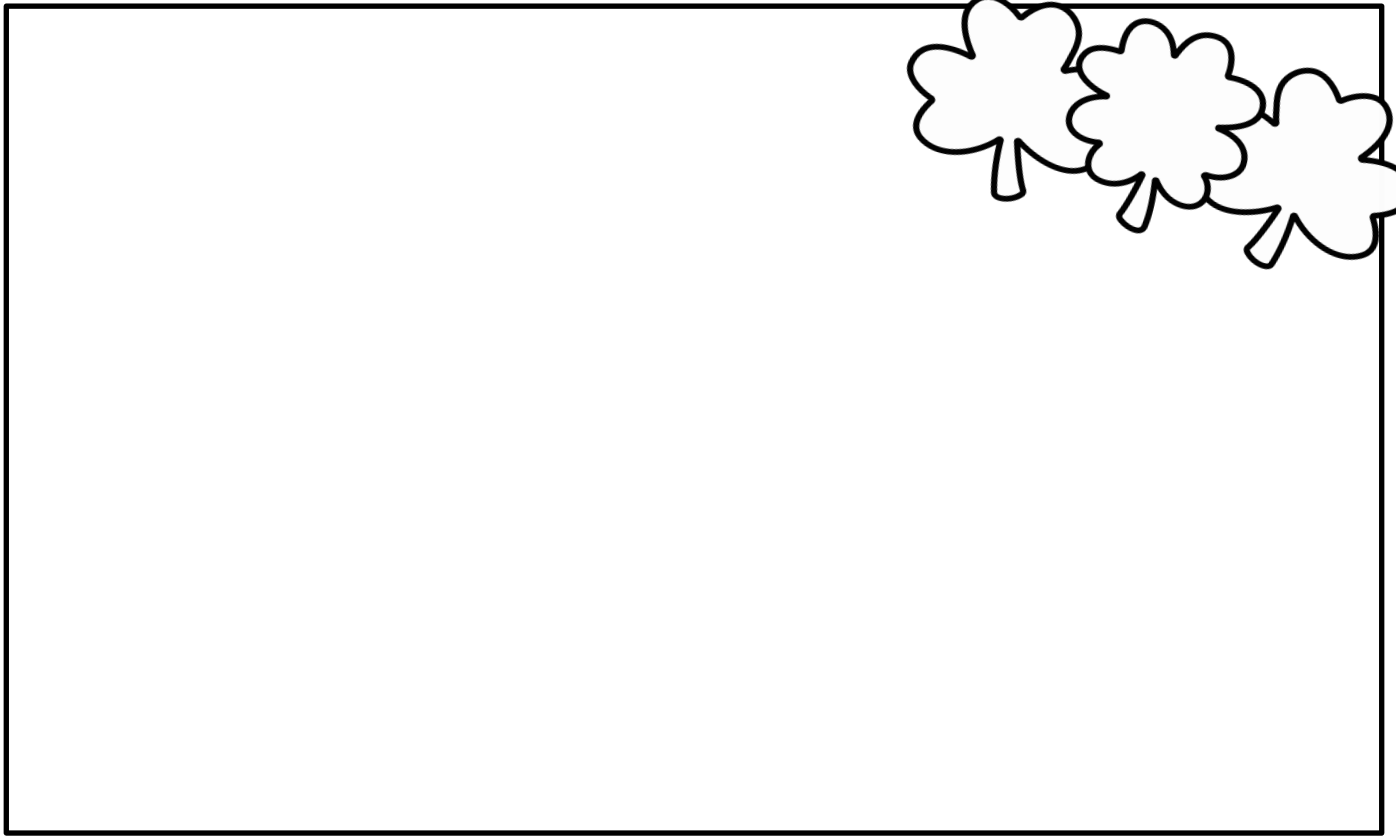
